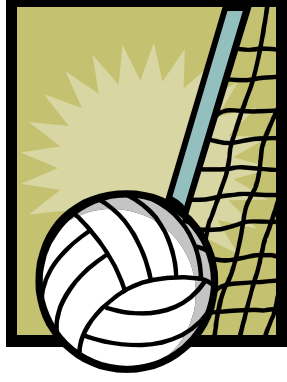

**"Rec" League**

All general rules apply to the league including the following:

1. Teams will be allow 9 players on the court per team.
2. Substitutions are to be made at serving position.
3. Teams will be allowed 15 player on the team rosters.
4. The net height will be set at 7 feet 4 7/8 inches.

**Co-Ed League**

All general rules apply to the league including the following:

1. 6 players shall be on the court per team.  
3 men and 3 women.
2. Short-handed Rule: Teams may play with 4 player as long as the ratio is 2:2 or 3:1 (female:male)
3. Men and Women must stand in alternating positions.
4. If the ball is hit more then once per side, a female must hit the ball before it is returned.
5. Substations shall be made on a male for male, and female for female basis.
6. The net height will be set at 7 feet 11 inches.
7. Teams will be allowed 12 players on the roster.



### Women's "A" League

All general rules apply to the league including the following:

1. Teams will play the maximum of 6 players on the court.
2. The net height will be set at 7 feet 4 7/8 inches.
3. No limit on substitutions. Sub at serving position.
4. Team rosters may consist of 12 players.



### Women's "B" League

All general rules apply to the league including the following:

1. Teams will play the maximum of 6 players on the court.
2. The net height will be set at 7 feet 4 7/8 inches.
3. No limit on substitutions. Sub at serving position.
4. Team rosters may consist of 12 players.

## General Rules

- Each team must complete and submit a "player registration sheet" & "team roster" prior to participating in first game. Players may only be listed on one teams roster or registration sheet.
- All non-residents of Massillon, not living within the city limits or working full time, participating in any City sponsored league will be assessed a \$1.00 per game fee. (Current Massillon Recreation Center Members will also be exempt)
- Three games equal one match. A match is won by the team winning the best of three games. All 3 games must be played.
- Forfeit of games will be 15 - 0. Forfeits will run as follows:
  - 1st game forfeit if less than four players at scheduled time.
  - 2nd game forfeit after 10 minutes.
  - 3rd game forfeit after 20 minutes.
- Team winning the coin toss will get the choice of first serve or choice of court the first and third game.
- Teams change direction of play after each game. At the beginning of new game, the players may be arranged in any position desired, regardless of their position on a previous game.
- All games will be played by rally scoring. First team to 25 wins the game (winning by two points.) Limit of 30 points. The last game will be first to 25 points (Regular season cap, tournament games must win by 2).
- The Server may serve from anywhere behind the baseline. Both feet must be behind the serving line, before and until the ball is struck. (Curtain end is allowed to step on the base line but not over on a serve.)
- Substitutions made at the serving position only.
- At least four (4) players must be on the floor at scheduled time of play.
- Ghost Player: Any team beginning with 5 players may establish a spot in the line up for a sixth player to be eligible for play. No other player can serve for the ghost player. (Side-Out) A team that doesn't wish to use a ghost player must complete the game with 5 players.
- NO CHANGES are to be made to a team roster after the mid-way point in of the season. No adding players during tournaments.
- If the previous match is won by forfeit that team will be permitted to participate in a practice game against anyone of their choosing until 15 minutes prior to the next scheduled match.



- The officials decision is FINAL. No arguments allowed. The official has the right to decide any problems that need immediate attention and League Director has the right to decide any problems of an ongoing nature or not covered within these rules.
- All other rules not stated are covered by OHSAA regulations.
- Any game cancelled due to weather or other reasons will be made up at the end of the regular scheduled season. All cancellations will be listed on the Massillon Parks & Recreation's Program Hotline at 330-832-1621.
- The braking procedure for regular season standings are as follows:
  - 1) overall record (games)
  - 2) Head to Head competition
  - 3) Highest point differential in head to head competition.
- Under extenuation circumstance, the Massillon Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to amend all rules for the best interest and safety of the League and its players.
- Standings will be determined by total win and losses of games, not matches.
- All players must check in at the Adult League Table with a picture ID before each game. Non-players/ spectators may be assessed a \$1 entrance fee per day.**

### Eligibility

- All players must be 16 years of age or older by the team's first match. No exceptions!
- No player shall play on more than one team during the same season.

### Levels of Play

- "Rec":** low to moderate skill level, the most recreational league we offer. Skill improvement is a benefit & everyone has a great time playing
- "B":** Mix of players with moderate to average skill proficiency & game knowledge. Focus on skill improvement, working on team concept & great sportsmanship.
- "A":** Mix of players with average to good skill proficiency & good game knowledge. Focus on evenly-matched, quality competition.
